Instructions Measuring



Supplies needed:

- ☐ Window Measurement Tracking Sheet
- ☐ Template for measurement
- ☐ Scissors for cutting out the template
- ☐ Masking tape
- □ Tape measure
- ☐ Pencil/pen
- Give each of your windows a descriptive name and record them on your Window Measurement Tracking Sheet.
- Print and cut out the four templates.(Color printing is helpful, but not required.)
- Using the top left template, align it with the top left corner of your window, outside the frame and secure it using masking tape.
 It's okay if the curve doesn't match, just ensure the "arms" of the template rest against the top and side of your window frame.
- Repeat for the other three corners.



The base for the turn-button is drawn next to the red dot. If the base will not fit beneath your valence, Turn Buttons will not work for your RV. Please choose a different method of attachment.

- Measure across the top from red dot to red dot, shown by the green arrow.
 IMPORTANT: Round up to the nearest inch.
 Write this number down on your tracking sheet as the width.
- Measure down the side from point to point, shown by the green arrow.
 IMPORTANT: Round up to the nearest inch.
 Write this number down on your tracking sheet as the length.
- Repeat for the remaining windows.

Window Location	Width	Height

to the right of your door.

Start with the window

in a clockwise direction.

Give each window

a description,

Work your way around

such as "Bedroom Left."

Width is measured

across the top.

Round to the nearest inch.

Height is measured

top to bottom.
